Scope of Services

This independent Contractor will use interpreter best-practices and due diligence to perform various assignments and tasks for a wide range of Bible translation organizations. Contractor will be a member of the Interpreter Workforce (IW) team, managed by the Interpreter Coordinator within the Operations department of Deaf Bible Society (DBS).

Contract Overview

The IW team receives requests from organizations within the Bible translation movement, national and international. The IW Interpreter Coordinator will manage all incoming interpreter requests and schedule with Contractor as assignments are made available. Contractor will be responsible for providing Sign Language Interpretation during group and individual meetings as requested or needed.

While interpreter engagements are not guaranteed, DBS will commit to providing opportunities for Contractor whenever possible. Contractor will agree to orientation and ongoing training as a member of the IW, with the ability to attend both in-person and virtual events, as possible, both national and international. Interpreting engagements may include hands-up time, voicing, transcribing, and sight translation.

Qualifications:

- Interpreters shall conduct all assignments following the Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf (RID)/National Association of the deaf's (NAD) Code of Professional Conduct (CPC).
- An Associate, Bachelor's or Master's level degree, or 4 years (8000) of full-time paid experience as an ASL interpreter.
- Interpreter must agree with DBS Statement of Faith
- Bilingual/International/Universal sign language is a BONUS!
